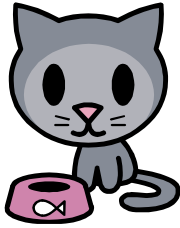


Donations to SuperChance Consignment Store for CCAR



CCAR now has an account set up at Super Chance - a great household consignment shop located in James Bay! This is a way for our wonderful supporters to raise money for CCAR, and clean out their cupboards at the same time!

They accept seasonal items, so that means no space heaters in the summer, fans in the winter, and holiday items only near that holidays, etc. To donate any items, please take your items to:

PLEASE NOTE - *A disposal fee may be applied to CCAR's account if items are not in usable/working order, as these items cannot be donated to the charities Super Chance uses (St. Vincent de Paul and Mustard Seed).

Refer to their Not Accepting List on their website, or call them if you are unsure about the items you would like to bring into the store.

To consign items (Drop Off option only) for CCAR Account at Super Chance:

- It is very important to tell them that the items are for Cat's Cradle Animal Rescue's account.
- There must be a minimum of 4 items that would have a selling value of at least \$5
- All items must be clean and in working order.

Fine Print:

When an item is sold 50% will go to CCAR. This is a great way for you to get better organized, and also help out CCAR. There is no need to contact anyone at CCAR, just drop off your items at the store during the suggested days and times listed above, and tell them that it is for Cat's Cradle Animal Rescue's account. It's that simple!

All paperwork, pricing, etc. is between Super Chance and the contact person for CCAR. Once items are brought in for CCAR's account, there is no way to get them back, or to find out how much it has sold for. If you have a valuable item, it would be best to donate it to our ongoing online auction when we get that up and running for the CCAR.
